Die „Jährliche Konferenz zur kulturellen Diplomatie“ ist die weltweit führende Veranstaltung für kulturelle Diplomatie, welche von ICD in Partnerschaft mit anderen führenden Institutionen am Ende eines jeden Jahres moderiert und organisiert wird.

Die aktuelle politische Situation und die Sicherheitslage in vielen Regionen und Ländern hebt zusammen mit der Verschlechterung sozialer Normen und dem Gebrauch von Gewalt die wachsende Notwendigkeit eines größeren kulturellen Dialogs hervor und wirbt für mehr Verständnis und Vertrauen um weitere Eskalationen zu vermeiden. Aus diesem Grunde wird sich die „Jährliche Konferenz zur kulturellen Diplomatie 2016“ auf das aufkommende Bewusstsein und diejenigen Aktivitäten konzentrieren, die globale Menschenrechte fördern.

Die „Jährliche Konferenz zur kulturellen Diplomatie 2016“ beabsichtigt alle erfolgreichen Praktiken im Sinne der Menschenrechte anzuwenden, welche das Tätigkeitsfeld der kulturellen Diplomatie der internationalen Gemeinschaft anzubieten hat für ihren Einsatz, um den wachsenden globalen Herausforderungen entgegenzutreten und Abhilfe zu verschaffen. Die Konferenz wird führende Politiker, Religionsführer, Akademiker und bekannte Künstler zusammenführen mit Repräsentanten aus den Konfliktregionen, um neue Institutionen und Initiativen zu gründen, die durch die Nutzung der angewandten kulturellen Diplomatie helfen werden, die Herausforderungen gemeinsam mit anderen Instrumenten und Methoden zu überwinden.



The Annual Conference on Cultural Diplomacy is the world's leading event in the field of cultural diplomacy hosted and organized by ICD in partnership with other leading institutions at the end of each year.

The current political and security situation in many regions and countries together with the deteriorations of social norms for the use of violence, emphasizes the growing need for a greater cultural dialogue, understanding and trust in order to avoid further escalation. The 2016 Annual Conference on Cultural Diplomacy will therefore focus, on raising awareness and support for activities that promote global human rights.

The 2016 Annual Conference on Cultural Diplomacy aims to present all successful CD practices in the area of human rights that the field of cultural diplomacy has to offer to the international community for their application to try to remedy and ease these growing global challenges. The conference will bring together leading politicians, religious leaders, senior academics and celebrated artists together with representatives from areas of conflict in order to establish new institutions and initiatives that will help with these challenges using the practice of cultural diplomacy together with other practices and means.
